


Durashield internal corner build-up



1.

- > Durashield Primer is used as first coat.
- > Durashield Topcoat is applied by brush or roller to the clean prepared and primed substrate.
- Position circular corner scrim reinforcement (A) into corner and embed into the wet Durashield Topcoat avoiding creasing.

2.

- > Cut and fold first piece of strip scrim reinforcement(B) and position as shown.
- > Fix in place by embedding into the wet Durashield Topcoat applied to upstand and horizontal deck ensuring a minimum of 50mm overlap onto the horizontal deck.
- Brush or roller the strip scrim reinforcement (B) to remove any trapped air and to bring the Durashield Topcoat through the strip scrim reinforcement (B) avoiding creasing.

3.

- > Cut and fold second piece of strip scrim reinforcement (C) and position as shown.
- > Fix in place by embedding into the wet Durashield Topcoat applied to upstand and horizontal deck ensuring a minimum of 50mm overlap onto the horizontal deck.
- Brush or roller the strip scrim reinforcement (C) to remove any trapped air and to bring the Durashield Topcoat through the strip scrim reinforcement (B) avoiding creasing.

4.

> Apply final coat of Durashield Topcoat to whole area.
